## Schellhorn Prize for Sacred Music Composition

### Conditions of Entry

- a. The work must be an original, unaided composition that will not have received its premiere, or be scheduled to receive its premiere, before Christmas Day in the year of the prize.
- b. Submitted scores must be legible and clearly laid out with the duration of the work included. The jury has the right to exclude scores that are not clearly presented.
- c. You must include with your submitted score a separate document giving the text in Latin and English also showing the source of the text.
- d. You must include proof that you are or were a student at a university or conservatoire in England or Wales, for example, a letter of confirmation, a photocopy of your degree certificate or student card.
- e. Entrants must be aged 30 or under on the closing date. A copy of your birth certificate, passport or equivalent document is required.
- f. As a contribution to the administrative costs of the award, an entrance fee of £5 per piece is payable. (Members of the Latin Mass Society and those in full time education at the closing date are not required to pay the entrance fee.)
- g. Former winners of the Prize are not eligible to enter again.
- h. Entries must be received at the above email address no later than 5pm on 7th December 2020. Entries arriving after this date will not be considered.
- i. All entries will be acknowledged by email and you will be notified of the result by email on Monday 14th December 2020.
- j. The winner will receive payment before the first performance of his/her work.
- k. The winner's composition will be performed during Mass on Christmas Eve at St Mary Moorfields Catholic Church in the City of London. (Should the Covid-19 situation preclude this performance, another performance opportunity will be arranged.)
